## VIDEOCONFERENCE, WEBINAR AND CHAT TOOL

### Description

Zoom is a cloud-based video conferencing service that you can use to meet virtually with others, either by video or audio only or both, while conducting live discussions. It allows you to record these sessions for later viewing.



### € Price

Zoom allows you to create free video meetings with up to 100 participants, up to a maximum of 40 minutes. Beyond 40 minutes, a paid version is required.

It is possible to record the course. Ability to create sub-groups. .



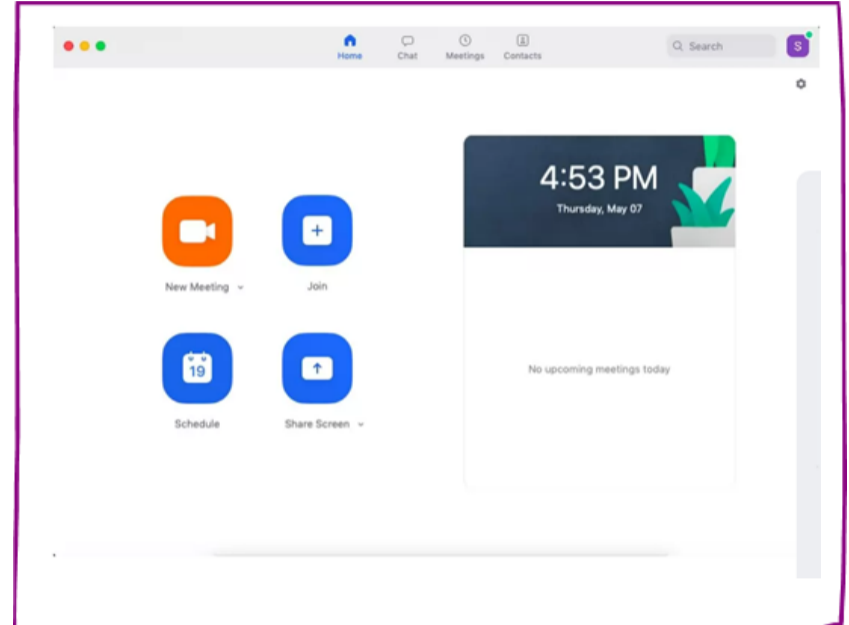
# HOW TO USE ?

## Step 1.

Create a new meeting.

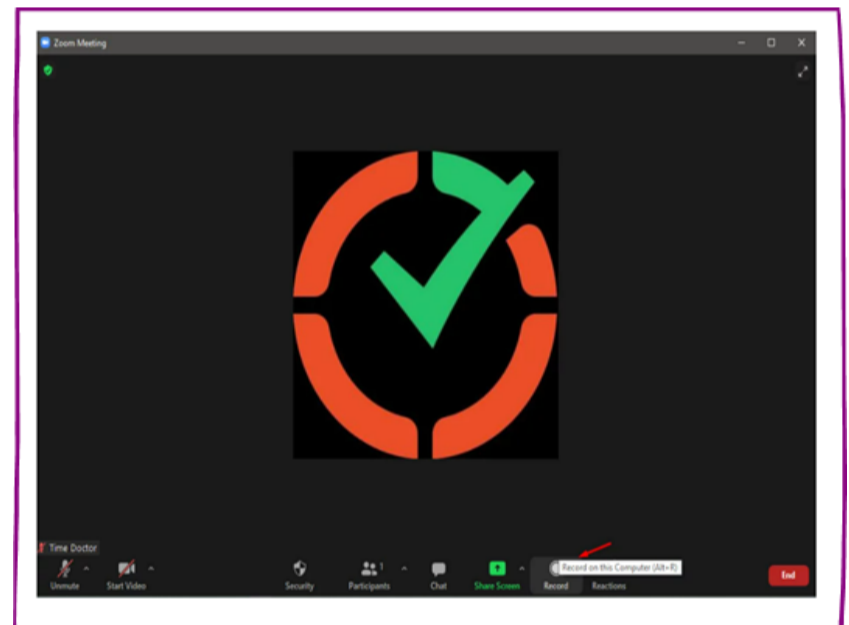
Schedule a meeting or generate a login link to invite people to participate.

You can also create subgroups with participants so that they can collaborate on an exercise for example.



## Step 3.

You can start a discussion and exchange documents with participants.
