INTERACTIVE PRACTICE TOOL

Description:

LearningApps.org is a versatile tool for learners and teacher who want to use or create a variety of different activities to practise with small interactive modules (which are incredibly useful for learners with SLDs).

The aim is to collect reusable building blocks and make them available to everyone. Blocks (called Apps) include no specific framework or a specific learning scenario which means they can be used and re-used at will and by anyone.

HOW TO USE?

LearningApps.org is easy to use, as it draws inspiration from what creators have done in the app. There is a wide range of options for your exercises and modules which makes it super interactive.

Step 1.

You can start by browsing some app to get some ideas, but once you are ready, click on: Create App

There, you will have to choose a template between the many options! (ex: Matching pairs, Number line, Multiple-choice, Crossword, etc.)



Step 2.

Once you've selected your template, you can either choose one of the examples of existing block and click on: create similar app, or you can create your own.

Fill in your information to create your own block, by adding titles, images, answers etc.
