  - adapting the content and form of written material airy page layout, highlighting every other line
- Material arrangements:

magnifying slats, reading guides

### Situation 1

#### Presentation of the student's difficulties:



A student has difficulty reading.

He/she reads slowly, jerkily. He/she gets discouraged quickly when faced with long texts.

Rarely completes work on time; slower than other students.

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### Situation 2

#### **Presentation of student's difficulties:**



A child who goes too fast.
Forgets parts of text or activity.
Skims over information.
He/she is often lost in the text because he/she wants to go too fast and then get flustered and gets discouraged

### Situation 3

### Presentation of student's difficulties:



This student has visual impairment.
He/she can see but cannot distinguish small letters and low contrast

Airy layout/ adapted font
Highlight important words or every other line
Reduce text/amount of reading
Magnifying slats
Reading guides
Immersive reader
Scanning pen
