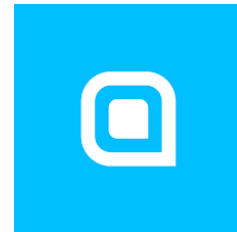


Generate QR code

Description

You can generate free QR codes on this website. A QR code is a two dimensional barcode that stores information in black and white dots (called data pixels or "QR code modules").



Price:

Free, online!

This resource can be helpful for students with:

- Learning disabilities.
- Difficulty in remembering and/or organizing.
- All students.



Accessibility grade

Students can use or generate QR codes to easily retrieve information presented in the course from the internet.

Practical use

Allows you to create links to web pages.

For example, you can put a QR code on learning materials to allow the student to find targeted literature or additional resources to help them take ownership of a learning.



Generate a QR code from a web link.

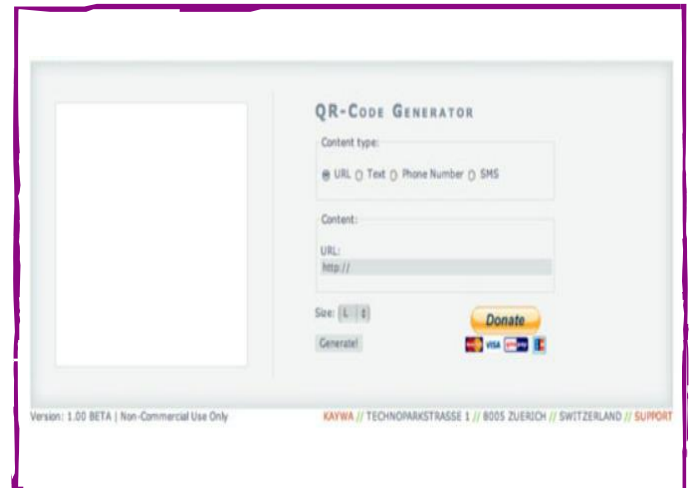
Step 1.

Go to the site: <http://www.qr-code-generator.com>

then copy/paste a link:

- URL
- text
- SMS
- ...

in the QR code generator.



Step 2.

Depending on where you want to place the QR code next, determine and choose the final size of the QR code.

Indeed, it is not recommended to change the size of the QR code when it has been generated, the smartphones might not detect it correctly anymore.

- *S*: One square inch (perfect size for your business card!)
- *M*: One and a half square inches.
- *L*: Two square inches.
- *XL*: Three square inches — a good size for a poster.

Step 3.

Click on the button to generate the QR code. Once it has been created, you can copy and paste it on the medium of your choice (word document, web page ...).
